

Rules of the World Cup in Fin Swimming (WC)

1. World Cup in Fin Swimming includes several rounds competition of the clubs and individuals from the countries.
2. World Cup calendar and the final evaluation are being secured alternatively every two years by Slovak and Slovenian diving federation. Every federation sends the final results of the club order to every participating club and federation.
3. A club, which is interested in the arranging of one round, sends the date when the competition will be held to the particular confederacy according to the point 2, the latest 31.03. of the year prior to the year when the competition will be held.
4. In each country only one round of WC during the particular year can be held.
5. In each round clubs from at least 3 countries must start.
6. Each club or individuals has right to participate in any round of the competition WC without other restriction.
7. Each member of the confederacy and its clubs has right to receive all information about WC.
8. The rules for all competitions are uniform and according to the international rules for the Fin Swimming.
9. Particular rounds can be held in 50 m or 25 m covered or open swimming pool.
10. Competition categories
 - 25 m swimming pool:
 - Apnea: 25 m, 50 m,
 - IMmersion: 100 m, 400 m
 - Fin Swimming: 50 m, 100 m, 200 m, 400 m
 - Relay: 4 x 100 m, 4 x 50 m
 - 50 m swimming pool:
 - Apnea: 50 m,
 - IMmersion: 100 m, 400 m, 800 m
 - Fin Swimming: 50 m, 100 m, 200 m, 400 m, 800 m, 1500 m
 - Relay: 4 x 100 m, 4 x 200 m

In each round there are 6 individual events and 2 relays.
11. Competition conditions:
 - the competition has 3 categories: A, B, C
 - each team consists of 8 competitors (without difference in gender), 1 leader, 1 coach, eventually 1 driver
 - one competitor can start in one round in maximum of 4 events and 2 relays
 - in one event can start maximum of 2 competitors from one category and one team
 - women can complete man relay but not the other way round
 - younger competitor can start for an older age group but the other way round, progress to an older age group is for whole round
 - to speed up the progress of the competition can participate competitors of all age groups in common heads, although the results are evaluated for each age group independent
 - guest competitors are allowed only in the case of agreement of the mother club, confirmed by national confederacy and this applies for the whole civil year. Guest competitors cannot start during this period for another club.

- performance of competitors is evaluated by 1000 – points table. Result of relays is multiplied by coefficient 2.
- in each round, first 3 competitors in the event and category as well as 3 winning teams will receive medal and eventually diploma.
- in each category first 3 competitors who achieve the most valuable time, evaluated by 1000 – point efficiency table, will receive medal. Organizer can, according to his ability, reward the winners and teams with a material gift.
- the final order of the clubs will be determined by sum of points received in 3 rounds of the highest sums received points. Winning club will receive cup of WC.
- the final order of the individuals will be ranked (by discipline/category) according to the sum of points received in 3 rounds with the highest sum scored points. A winning athlete will receive a mini-cup of WC.

12. Final competition (FINAL OF THE WORLD CUP IN FIN SWIMMING)

- the best 15 clubs in year + club organiser and the best 10 athletes of each event can participate in the final competition.
- the final competition must take place in 50m swimming pool,
- the final competition must take time for minimum of four days
- in the final competition all disciplines/categories (A,B,C) and distances must be organised.
- a club can participate in all events by WC rules,
- an individual may participate only in the event in which she/he has scored points within the best ten results in year
- the final order of the club will be determined by sum of points in 3 rounds + sum of points in final competition. The best club will be the Club World Cup Winner for current year
- the final order of the individuals will be determined by sum of points in 3 rounds + points received in the final competition for each event. The best individual (discipline/category) will be the Individual World Cup Winner for current year
